CAR SEAT AND CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY

Every parent and caregiver is responsible to ensure that all children under their care are as safe as can be at all times. While riding in a motor vehicle, the only way to do this is to ensure the child is properly restrained.

Children under 13 years old don't belong in the front seat!



THE LIGHT SEAT



Birth to 2 years old

Rear facing in infant/convertible child safety seat



2+ years old and met height/weight minimum Forward-facing child safety seat with 5 point harness



4+ years old and met height/weight minimum Belt positioning booster seat



9+ years old; outgrown booster seat, pass the 5 step test Lap shoulder seatbelt in the vehicle's rear seat



IT'S THE LAW

Every driver in LA who transports a child/children under the age of 18 years in a motor vehicle that is in motion, shall have the child properly restrained according to the vehicle and child safety seat manufacturer's instructions
